



PARENT AGREEMENT 2011-2012

I have read, understand and agree to the following:

To pay a registration fee of \$ _____

To pay a monthly fee/tuition of \$ _____ for running expenses whether my child is able to attend every day or not.

1. I understand the goals and objectives of this class for my child.
2. I will attend a minimum of two Parent Education Classes per semester to learn about child development, parenting skills, and receive pertinent information regarding my child's specific class. I understand that all parent classes are mandatory and if more than one is missed, it must be made up within SIX weeks after the missed parent class in accordance with Article IV, Section B of the Standing Rules.
3. I will help at one of the scheduled deep-cleaning events at the Preschool.
4. I will come to school on my workday. If I am unable to attend, I will make every effort to find a substitute and notify my Parent Leader. I understand excessive unexcused absences on my workday will be dealt with at the Board's discretion.
5. I will commit my time to prepare for and participate in the annual fund raising activity. If I am unable to participate, I will engage in a compensatory activity. The amount and timing of this alternative fundraising will be determined by the Board of Trustees.
6. I will serve and actively participate on one standing committee, unless I am serving on the Board of Trustees.
7. I will read and abide by the Handbook, Standing Rules and Bylaws of the Cooperative.
8. I will keep my child home from school when signs of illness are present (as described in the Handbook).
9. I will pay tuition and fees when scheduled. I will reimburse the Preschool for any fees charged to the Preschool by a bank due to returned checks. Late fees of \$15 per month will be assessed for any payment not received by the 15th day of the month it is due.

In return for my cooperative participation, I can expect the Preschool to do the following for its members:

1. Provide activities suitable for the age and developmental level of the child.
2. Conduct classes in general accordance with the Riverview School District calendar.
3. Provide sufficient adult supervision to insure a positive experience for each child.
4. Use educational and safe materials.
5. Provide parent education classes which are of interest to the parents involved.

Should I be unable to fulfill my responsibilities, I will endeavor to arrange an alternative solution or, if none is found, to give two week's notice and withdraw from the group. (Both parents should sign this agreement if they will both participate at Preschool).
